

Transcription of letter from Mary Talbot to Henry Davenport, dated 1st November 1721

I can't help writing again tho' this is the fourth I've sent to Worfeild since I came home, & have heard but once by a letter Mr Talbot had from S^{is} Ivory, of dear Harrys illness; who' I long to hear is well again: we have a good deal of company that dined with us to day, & are to stay till fryday morning, & then Mr Talbot leaves this place for London, I am
